We strongly believe that the first years of life are the foundation of a child's future life performance. Our infant curriculum focuses on offering experiences that enhance exploration in all sensory areas from three to 12 months with milestone development-based activities that awaken and integrate a child's neurological system. Sensory-based activities assist in developing a child's social, physical and future academic success. The main goal of our neurological and sensory-based infant program is to enhance a child's brain capacity and emotional maturity level.



We provide caring, loving and trained teachers who assist infants through all the stages of the early stimulation process.



KEYS ASPECTS OF OUR CHILD CARE PROGRAM

*Research has shown that this delicate developmental stage is one when the greatest number of neural connections occurs, therefore, we work with children using a broad Spanish Immersion Program based on both physical and mental stimulation.

*The best time to begin the study of a second language is in the earliest years. Our Spanish immersion instruction is characterized by its highly academic quality, primarily due to the fact that our teachers are native speakers of the Spanish language.

*We place equal importance on assuring the children learn to be internationally-minded, well organized, well mannered, obedient, responsible and exhibit virtues and attitudes that are meaningful in developing positive personal habits.

*This is the stage in life when children develop their personalities, character and value systems. Therefore, we are helping them develop a conscious mind able to distinguish right from wrong.

PRE-TODDLER PROGRAM THROUGH TWO YEARS OLD

Our curriculum is designed to guide and develop the social, emotional, self-control, physical and neurological skills needed for future success.

Communication skills are a vital component of the curriculum as children expand their vocabularies and assign meaning to new experiences. With our Spanish immersion approach, toddlers are rapidly learning a second language as quickly as their native language.

Exploring the world inspires a child to examine, create and share as he broadens his language through interactions with his teachers and classmates in a safe, nurturing environment. Sensory and repetitive activities transform these new experiences into knowledge.

Our program also incorporates circle time, music, art, and dramatic play to encourage and shape your child's creativity and imagination. Activities promote the development of physical skills, from running and jumping, to dressing and pre-writing.



ART SKILLS

Art experiences emphasize the process rather than the product. Time, space and the freedom to work independently help children increase their attention span and improve fine motor skills. Plus, art is an enriching emotional experience.

In our community of exploration, your child can learn, grow and celebrate the world around him/her.

COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT

Increasing cognitive skills in three to five year olds includes problem solving and logical thinking activities. Children are encouraged to use their creativity and curiosity when they encounter new tasks. To develop logical thinking skills, our teachers read carefully selected children's books throughout the day, encouraging the children to answer questions and express opinions about the stories.





PRE-K PROGRAM 3 & 4 YEARS OLD

Our three and four year program is designed to inspire your children to be creative, interactive explorers and be active participants in their learning.

Our curriculum follows NAEYC guidelines with monthly thematic units in alignment with our International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (PYP).

Teachers guide your child's inquisitiveness and elevate his/her thinking level so they can make discoveries independently.



Skills and concepts learned in the classroom are reinforced and extended throughout the year.



PHYSICAL SKILLS

Jardin de Niños Interlingua has adopted a unique physical education program used to enhance neuro-motor sensory integration and language for maximum development of each child's innate potential.

SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

As children move from preschool through kindergarten, their social and emotional skills need the guidance of a nurturing teacher. Teachers design activities to increase children's independence, allow them to become more confident in their abilities, and prompt them to play a responsible role in their classroom communities.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

Our program offers children the opportunity to freely to express their thoughts, ideas, questions, opinions, new words, and new phrases with their friends and teachers. Children will be immersed in a print-rich environment, boosting their pre-literacy skills.



MATH & SCIENCE SKILLS DEVELOPMENT
